When it comes to inclusion, neurodiversity refers to a world where neurological differences are recognised and respected as all other human variations. Depending on how our brains are wired we think, move, process information and communicate in different ways. Many people in our community use neurodiversity as an umbrella term used to describe alternative thinking styles such as Dyslexia, DCD (Dyspraxia), Dyscalculia, Autism and ADHD. But regardless of labels, neurodiversity is about recognising those who think differently.

In school this week Mrs Bloomfield led an assembly to help our school community understand some of the differences and challenges that some children and adults experience everyday. We also watched a video together about Autism and some classes did extra activities throughout the week. We also learnt about what to do if we need help and we are out and about alone, which was really useful for our Year 5 and 6 children who are starting to become more independent. The handy hints we were given were:-

- If you need help out and about, look for a mum or a dad with children and ask them to look after you.
- If you are still near school, go back to school straight away.
- If you are near a shop, go into that shop to ask for help.
- If you need to, shout 'Help!' as loudly as you can.

• If you have a phone, you can phone the police on 999 but still make sure you find a safe adult to help as well.

What handy tips! We also loved having a look at the police van. It was quite the Monday afternoon treat!

Finally, Ash and Chestnut classes had a visit from Dr Keir from the Harpenden Dental Centre. Dr Keir talked about how to brush teeth properly and then demonstrated on Mrs Down how plaque disclosing tablets work so that you can see which parts of your teeth are still dirty even after brushing.

The children loved seeing Mrs Down with a coloured tongue and were keen to try the tablets themselves when brushing their own teeth.






Don't forget to order your sunflower seeds to take part in the FoSW sunflower competition. 2 seeds for £3 via Classlist or FoSW postbox.
